The 1st, 2^{nd} , 3rd, 4^{th} classes will qualify for the BSPS championships show provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Roger's Truck Services Ltd Challenge

Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show & competing in the appropriate Class- Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Hunter Pony, Open Working Hunter Pony, and the Open Intermediate SRT, SH, and WH, and the Heritage Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes will qualify. Ponies must not have qualified for the 2024 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Binks Family Champion of Champions. 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify-Open Lead, Rein First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open W.H.P, Nursey Stakes, Open S.H.P.

Owners and riders must be BSPS members to compete in classes with RIHS and Blue Riband Qualification and animals must be registered with the BSPS except for the Anglo & Part Bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS

This show is a qualifier Blue Riband the 1st and 2nd in the following classes will qualify. Open Lead Rein & First Ridden, 123cms, 133cms, 143cms, 143cms, 153cms, 143cms, 153cms, 148cms Show Pony. The 1st and, 2nd in the following classes will qualify Intermediate Show Riding type, Show Hunter and Working Hunter ponies.

This Show is a Qualifier for the UK Ponies & Horses Ltd Gold Medal Series to take place at Spring Classic 2025.1st 2nd & 3rd placed competitors in classes 29-33 will qualify. Qualifications cards are not given out in the ring however results can be verified by the office.

BODY PROTECTORS-Body Protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes Including practice rings at B.S.P.S. affiliated shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes). Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organised and affiliated events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label. BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. All types of Air Jackets are not allowed.

HATS-Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 and 2023, SNELL E2016 and E2021, AS/NZS 3838 2006, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover, either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. Tagging indicates that the hat meets the accepted standards, no check of the fit or condition of the hat is implied. It is considered to be the responsibility of the members/guardians to ensure the hat complies with the current standards and is tagged before they compete. Members/guardians are responsible for ensuring the manufacturer's guidelines with regard to fit and replacement are followed. Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory at BSPS Winter, Summer and Heritage Championship shows, Royal International Horse Show, London International Horse Show, Burghley Gold Cup and lead rein WSP final. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags) No pony or horse allowed on the showground that is not entered in a class.

BSHA Classes RIHS qualifying classes

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders and must be Association Members or have a Day Ticket, as appropriate. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

Classes 47-48, 50-51, 53-55, are qualifiers for Open championships at The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward, with the exception of BSHA shows, where qualification will go down the line.

Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

Classes 56 -59 are qualifiers for the Amateur Championships at The Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed unqualified horse in each section in each class in the Hack, Cob and Riding Horse classes will qualify for the RIHS Amateur final, with the two highest placed unqualified horses qualifying in the Maxi Cob class.

The BSHA offer a Champion rosette to be awarded in the separate Amateur Championship. Please refer to rules 6 & 7 in the 2024 BSHA Rulebook. The Amateur qualifying classes may be entered on a day ticket, but appropriate membership and horse registration must be applied for within 14 days of the qualifier in order to confirm qualification.

DAY TICKETS & SHOW TICKETS

Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets and two Show Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider, and Open Affiliated classes only, but will NOT allow entry into RIHS (except Amateur classes) or HOYS qualifying classes. A Show Ticket has the same criteria and covers all days of a Show running for longer than one day. Horses registered on a Day / Show Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day / Show Ticket by applying online on the BSHA website.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse, Racehorse to Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes). Recipients of the Young Rider rosette will qualify for the BSHA Young Rider of the Year at the National Championship Show in September 2024. BSHA SUPREME OF YEAR FINALS

The highest placed unqualified exhibit in the top 5 in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of the Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA National Championship Shows in September 2024.
